Each four-hour session is technically oriented and reviews the regulations from the standpoint of an installer who wishes to conform to all applicable requirements while maximizing profits for his employer. The course carries four (4) NORA Continuing Education Credits (CEU's.)

The seminar features workarounds and methods that provide for Code Compliance, operating safety and proper operation and is ideal for both apprentices and senior technicians, sales personnel, managers, Fire Inspectors and anyone else involved in the installation, inspection and servicing of oilheat equipment while working in Massachusetts.
